I wanted to follow up with you on our conversation today.

- In regards to the settlement question. I reached out to the attorney that handled the case and her response was:  
*You are correct that the difference here (from Spokane) is that the settlement amount was within your approval authority as Mayor, and you approved it; City Council approval was not required for this reason. The Council was provided the memorandum for informational purposes.*
